'A' Boards

Hi,

I'm writing as co-Chairman of the CIC to the town council.

The CIC notes that the minutes of the May meeting of the town's Chamber of Trade include the following:

"A note from Mark Nelson. Concerns were raised over Eden's spread outside of shop. MN reported that customers had mentioned to him the amount on footpath. GB (Geoffrey Buswell) commented a number of businesses were putting A boards out. Agreed this is a town council issue, not a COT issue."

While some may wonder why the Chamber cannot discuss this issue with their members, we are aware that the use of A-boards and other pavement furniture is increasing in the town centre. Could we ask that the town council writes to the Chamber, asking them to remind members that there is a Code of Practice in place which does allow the sensible use of A-boards. Such material, along with display furniture on our narrow pavements, seriously impedes the safe movement of pedestrians, especially those with young children or who are disabled.
