a.	The Title Register and Title Plan was purchased by NH for KLTC. Documents show clear areas of ownership and adjacent land rights.		
	Land known as 'Ruskins View' immediately North of the Radical Steps is owned by		
	KLTC but was never registered at the Land Registry. NH recommends to the Council		
	that the property is registered, thus recording and safeguarding the title to the land for future generations.		
	The application cost for this is small (potentially as little as £20), but it will involve		
	getting at minimum a formal copy of the deeds from Kendal Archive Centre (£15
