Kevin, I have a suggestion/ proposal I would like the council members to consider. In addition to the KLTC we have three significant community "action" groups in KL. They are a) The Brow/Ruskin's View, b) The Community Cupboard and c) The Community Interest Company (CIC). Both a) & b) have now transformed into registered charities. My proposal is that all the details relating to these three bodies be included with the KLTC information on the notice board outside the Lunesdale Hall. This information should include the formal name, registration no, names of trustees and/or directors as appropriate. This information is in the public domain, if an enquiring individual is prepared to trawl through the internet, they will eventually find what they're seeking ... assuming the relevant websites are up to date. I personally, would also like to see included the names of any key managers &/or employees of these three bodies. I don't think the anonymity of each of these three bodies helps when referred to in KL as "The trustees of .." or "The directors of .." All three of these bodies repeatedly look to the KLTC for some form of funding ...
