**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990
TREE PRESERVATION ORDER No. 3 (Kirkby Lonsdale) 1982**

I am writing to notify Kirkby Lonsdale Town Council that the National Park Authority has recently given consent, under the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, for the following works to take place to a tree covered by the above Tree Preservation Order, along the public footpath at Ruskin's viewpoint, Kirkby Lonsdale:

- One scots pine: remove and clean up broken limb
- One Sycamore: remove ivy, dead wood, and some small diameter branches that overhang the path
- One ash: fell to a safe height
- Fell four ash, and remove one over-extended branch of one further ash in this group.
